Angling Matters:

Members' Angling Reports (including any reports from previous Members Night):

- 1. John Healey fished Gough's Bay, Eildon, for 8 trout 35-40 cm on Tassie Devils. He also mentioned a second hand report of Murray Cod to 73 cm/8 kg trawling stump jumpers
- 2. Don Ellis gave a second hand report that Oakdale fished the Goulburn from Alexandra to Thornton before the June long weekend, with every member catching fish many in the 30-35 cm range, and 3 over 1 kg, the heaviest being 1.095 kg. The revier was flowing at 1500-2000 ML.
- 3. Lou Gerardi spent 2 days at Wonthaggi, but the salmon hadn't started running.
- 4. There was a second hand report that Keysborough AC fished Woodside Beach for 9 fish with 3 over 1 kg. However, fishing on the eastern beaches has generally been poor.

Trip Captain's Report: S2/3 Woodside/McLoughlins Beaches – George GreenMost members turned up on the Friday before the comp started, and fished "Ormond" and McLoughlins Beach, without success – the beaches were generally very flat and shallow and there was virtually no surf, but plenty of crabs. Two fish were lost in the wash.

On the Saturday (the S2 competition) 6 members fished Woodside, McLoughlins and Reeves beaches, for ZERO fish weighed in.

At Woodside at low tide, members could wade out to the first sand bank and only be ankle deep, but only a few undersized salmon and trevally were put back. Towards high tide on Reeves and McLoughlins beaches, there was a reasonable amount of water, but still no fish. Locals said that the fish hadn't come in to the beaches to date.

The Angling Committee decided to postpone the S3 Sunday competition to the following weekend.

Trip Captain's Report: S3 Williamsons Beach Saturday 13 June – George Green 5 members fished Williamsons Beach, most staying at a huge hole right where the track comes down to the beach. Other parts of the beach were still forming gutters, etc, and some parts were quite rocky. However, the fish again didn't cooperate. Another angler

nearby was seen to catch a salmon >1kg on cut pilchard, but that was the only fish of note on the day.

Peter Manning took an average size salmon on a popper, being the only size fish by an OAC member.

Trip Captain's Report: S4 – Peter Manning

In a word, the surf started off "angry", and got even more savage and dangerous in the run up to high tide. There was still a big hole sweeping out to the right that looked good, where the track comes down to the beach. However, there were strong side currents, with the occasional piece of weed. At high tide, waves were running almost up to the sand dunes in places.

Weather was pleasant with light winds and only one passing shower, but fishing was poor, and crabs were a nuisance.
